 - Attended the NCTA Leadership zoom call
 - Will try to post more on FB and IG, met with Felicia to discuss marketing strategy
- Chris Fothergill, Wilderness Clearing
 - We have a CCMI crew going out to do some work in early June Pine Ridge Trail to Gogebic for 8 days
 - Brian, Chris, Felicia, and Bob Westphal met to talk about wilderness clearing trips, which areas need attention and crew leaders to contact. We're meeting again in a couple weeks to set dates for wilderness trips
- Gary Carlson, Non Wilderness Clearing
 - Larry and John are doing a sweeping on the West end May 11-14 (need signage and brush sweeping)
 - Gary will focus on doing a sweep on the East end (brushing and tree falls)
 - We should consider mileage reimbursement to send volunteers to training like CPR/First Aid and Chainsaw/Crosscut Certs
 - o Garry suggested that we charge all trips the same and not just "non wilderness"
 - Last year we charged \$20 refundable fee and most people donated it to the club
 - Charging for the trips is helpful to promote attendance and to fund group meals
 - Andrew suggested sending out an email campaign about donating to help with clearing trip expense for folks that can't make it out in person
 - Gary proposed that the trip fee is \$25 per person for all clearing trips and if they show up they can have it refunded or donate it to the BRTA, nonrefundable if they DON'T show up
 - Motion to approve by Brian, John Second, All approved
- Larry Quinn, Board Member
 - We should be able to patch together the trailer for a couple hundred dollars and hold off on purchasing a new one for a couple more years
- Matt Davis, NCTA RTC
 - We have a contract with a CCMI Crew (mentioned above from Chris) to work from Pine Ridge and Gogebic, 8 days in the wilderness section of the trail
 - There is some general confusion about which parts of the trail need attention because of flooding - Daniel's Lake Spur and Long Portage
 - USFS said the Daniels Lake Spur is on State Land, so they are not responsible. It's on school trust lands, which complicates any sort of trail issues, but Matt is hoping to work it out.

- The Long Portage has some thigh deep flooding and the USFS said they would be willing to problem solve a fix to this area themselves and will send someone out this spring to evaluate.
- Chris and Brian would both like to be involved in the conversations with the USFS
- Larry added that the section of the trail next to Loon Lake was knee deep last year we'll look this year to see if it's still problematic and report back
